

COSTUME LIST - LIFE IS A CABARET...

As a cast member you are responsible for coming up with the majority of your costume pieces. Below is a list of the general looks for each number. This is a workshop production so we do the best we can to create the looks without spending much money. Search closets and ask your parents and friends. Then try a thrift store. If needed Mrs. VS will borrow some things from the HHS theatre costume shop. Do not go to Mrs. Dillard yourself. You must go through Mrs. VS. HOWEVER, you must make the effort to come up with most things.

Show t shirts will be made and they will be your costume for the opening number. The cost of the t shirts is \$10 payable to HHS Choral Boosters.

We will have parents at rehearsal this coming Sat Jan, 28th to start checking off what you have. Everyone is required to bring at least three costumes to rehearsal on Sat.

1. Opener – Cabaret, from Cabaret - Show T Shirts (will be provided) and Black pants and shoes
2. With a little bit of Luck , from My Fair Lady – Plaid button shirts, Khaki or dark pants, Suspenders or vest, Maybe a corduroy jacket with sleeves rolled etc. Maybe a page boy hat.
3. On the Street where You live, From My fair Lady – aristocratic , Ascot, dress shirt, dress coat and top hat perhaps.
4. Wouldn't it be Lovely, from My Fair Lady – Liz Peterson- floral drop waist dress, ankle boots, hat with a flower
5. Lady's Who lunch, from Company- Emma M-C - Dark pants suit and heels with shell
6. Forget about the Boy – All Women- 20's drop waist dresses or skirts and tops. Long sweaters over skirts, Character shoes.
7. Benjamin Calypso , from Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat - All Men - Bright plain colored T shirt – Red, yellow, Royal blue, (calypso sleeves provided by Mrs VS. Blue Jeans rolled up to show ankles. Jazz shoes no socks. Straw caribbean hats maybe.
8. You Could Drive a Person Crazy, from Company - pencil skirts, short sleeve blouses and heels. Hair up.
9. First Act Closer – Masquerade , from Phantom of the Opera – Gowns and tuxedos. Tuxedos (provided by Mrs. VS) Gowns should be as long as possible, ankle is best. The brighter the color the better. Thrift store Bridesmaid would work. If you cannot find one on your own, We can try to make a short list of people to find gowns for in the theatre costume room.

10. 2nd act opener - Show People from Curtains, - Full Cast – Black dress pants, Red t shirts. Boas for girls and vests for men Provided by Mrs. VS.
11. Rock Island, from Music Man – Dress like traveling salesmen. White Dress shirt, dark dress pants belts and dress shoes. Fedora hats maybe, loose ties, suspenders or suit coats.
12. I'm Always Chasing Rainbows, from Oh, Look! – pretty dress, flowing knee length skirt. Lighter color if possible.
13. Anything You Can Do I Can Do Better, from Annie Get your Gun – Cowboy and cowgirl. Plaid, chaps? Jeans, boots? Hats maybe. Holsters no guns 😊
14. The Things You Can Think, from Seussical – Think Wacky tacky day. BRIGHT colors that don't match. Funny big hats and shoes. Think clown like. Big clown glasses. Funny wigs.
15. I Could Be Happy With You, from The Boyfriend – Sidney- pretty flapper dress (See Mrs VS), Cameron, Vest and dress shirt, dress slacks. Coordinate Colors.
16. Human Heart – Beachy flowy in light colors, like Capris with tunic like tops, flowy blouse, wide sleeves, flip flops. Try to stay in neutral light tones, white, cream, khaki, pink, coralgrey
17. Our Time, from Merrily We roll along – Complimentary outfits. See Mrs. VS
18. Bosom Buddies, from Mame – time period – 30s – like the movie.
19. Love Song, from Pippin – Dark slacks, pirate shirt like men' number last year. Kelsey, Long flowing skirt, peasant top.
20. Finale - Steal your Rock and Roll from Memphis – Men - Black tux pants and shirts w/ sequined vests (Mrs. VS Has these)
- Women – Light blue sparkle dresses (Provided by Mrs. VS) Character Shoes
